- 3. The top of the poster must have a label indicating its title and authors
- 4. All illustrations should be prepared beforehand. Your illustrations should be readable from a distance of about 1 metre. Keep illustrations simple.
- 5. Posters must not be mounted on heavy board because they may be difficult to keep in position on the poster stands.
